1 General remarks

With regard to the sales promotion and placing on the market of machinery, the Swiss Federal law governing the safety of products (PrSG, SR 930.11) and the corresponding ordinance on the safety of machinery (MaschV, SR 819.14) require proof that the essential health and safety requirements are satisfied. This also includes a declaration of conformity issued by the manufacturer or by the manufacturer's authorised representative in Switzerland.

Where machines and partly completed machinery are concerned, the minimum requirements expected of the content of the declarations of conformity or declarations of incorporation are contained in Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC, Annex II.

This document contains sample declarations of conformity that satisfy the abovementioned minimum requirements.

The meaning of the individual entries is explained in the following chapter.


Anybody issuing a declaration of conformity must take into account that this constitutes a legal statement. Its contents must therefore be a true representation of the facts.

2 Meaning of the individual entries


- For machines, an "EC Declaration of Conformity" according to Annex II 1. A. of the Machinery Directive has to be drawn up. Thus, the manufacturer declares, that the machine complies with all the essential health and safety requirements.
 For partly completed machinery, a "Declaration of Incorporation" according to Annex II 1. B. of the Machinery Directive has to be drawn up. The original versions of these declarations have to bear the words "Original EC Declaration of Conformity" and "Original Declaration of Incorporation" respectively.
- ② Business name and full address of the manufacturer and where appropriate his authorised representative.
- ③ A description and identification of the product, including generic denomination, function, model, type, serial number and commercial name. The type designation and serial number guarantee for complete traceability. For large machines generally a single declaration of conformity is issued. However, for series production, a single declaration of conformity can be issued for an entire batch.
- ④ In the case of EC Declarations of Conformity:
 - Explicit declaration that the machine complies with all the essential requirements of the Machinery Directive.
 - Where appropriate, a declaration that the machine complies with the essential requirements of other European Directives.
 - The Directive references according to publication in the Official Journal of the European Union must be given.
- 5 In the case of Declarations of Incorporation:
 - A declaration of which essential requirements of the Machinery Directive are applicable and are met.
 - Where appropriate, a declaration that the machine meets the essential requirements of other European Directives.
 - The Directive references according to publication in the Official Journal of the European Union must be given.
 - A declaration that the relevant technical documentation has been compiled in accordance with Annex VII Part B and a reference that this relevant technical documentation must be sent in response to a reasoned request by national authorities.
 - A statement that the partly completed machinery must not be put into service until the final machinery into which it is to be incorporated has been declared in conformity with the provisions of the Machinery Directive.

- ⁶ Name and address of the person who is authorized to compile the technical file or the relevant technical documentation. This person can be a natural or a legal person.
- If the conformity assessment involves an "EC Type-examination" or a "Full quality assurance": the name, address and identification number of the notified body which carried out the corresponding conformity assessment procedure as well as the number of the type-examination certificate.
- If applicable, the references to any harmonised standards used, which are listed in the Official Journal of the European Union with reference to the presumption of conformity.
- If applicable, the references to any other technical standards and specifications used.
- Place and date of the declaration plus identity and signature of the person empowered to draw up the declaration on behalf of the manufacturer or his authorised representative.


